History

Trinity dates to the 1880s with a small congregation meeting in area schoolhouses. Our first building began in 1887, with several moves before our present building in 1903. The parish grew steadily and enjoyed its strongest years in the latter half of the 20th Century. We lost members over the national church (and our) move to greater inclusivity in 2003, the movement away from organized religions nationally and finally the Covid Pandemic. We are at present in the midst of a revitalization let by Priest-in-Charge Very Rev. Bill Dunn and our strong loyal lay nucleus.

Programs and Organizations

We have a strong musical and liturgical tradition, but also many other worship offerings for special occasions, recently adding a trial period of Messy Church. Youth ministry has a strong tradition, with our Annual residential Summer Camp being the centerpiece. We are currently rebuilding other youth programs that waned during the pandemic. Fellowship also waned during the pandemic and is now rebounding. We have strong community outreach, pastoral care with both priestly and lay visiting. Adult education programs are being rebuilt. Communications with the membership are strong with several offerings.

Financial

We are strong financially, with a reasonable endowment, regular stewardship, and broad support for special projects when needed.
